JUNE CLASSES

(Rising 3rd through 8th graders) Disney's SLEEPING BEAUTY KIDS

Musical Performance camp: Members of this workshop will have loads of fun working on Disney's SLEEPING BEAUTY! It's Princess Aurora's 16th birthday, and fairies Flora, Fauna and Merryweather must use their magic to save her from the spell of evil sorceress Maleficent! Classic songs including "Once Upon a Dream," accompany fun new songs like "Maleficent!" and "A Little Magic Now" to bring a fresh telling of the story. Other characters include: King Stephan, Queen Stefanie, Prince Phillip, Maleficent's goons (Fumpfel, Pest, Blather, and Stench), Owl, Frog, Birds, loyal subjects, guards, goons, and other fairies. This workshop culminates in two public performances! 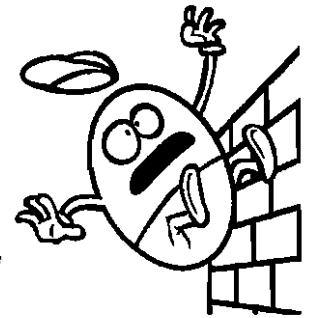

(Rising 1st -2nd, ages 6 and 7) Princes, Pigs, and Pixiedust: Exploring the world of make-believe with familiar storybook characters will be the theme of this creative drama workshop. Students will practice basic performance skills through fun theatre games, storytelling, and improvisations. (Rising 4th & 5th graders) Myths and Legendary Tales: Take a romp on Mount Olympus as we explore mythology in this creative drama workshop. Students will develop improvisation and ensemble skills through fun theatre games. (ages 7-12) Basically Ballet: Come and learn about the exciting world of classical ballet! Dancers will be introduced to basic ballet fundamentals, including classroom etiquette, body alignment, vocabulary, and basic positions of the feet & arms. A piece will also be learned to be shown on the last day of class. Students should wear a leotard with pink tights and leather ballet slippers. Moms & Daughters - Dance Fusion! Dance fusion is for anyone who wants to move! The class will have a high energy warm up with jazz, modern, and pilates techniques and throughout the class, you'll be learning fun and easy modern style and hip hop dances. No dance experience required! Anyone 8 and older is welcome to join in the fun. Comfortable clothing should be worn with hair pulled away from the face.
